

Citizen Schein Citizen Schein



The documentary Citizen Schein tells the true story of a Jewish war refugee who arrived alone in Sweden at the age of 14. He later became one of Sweden's most influential public figures in the post-war era. Harry Schein was no ordinary cultural profile or businessman. He was a powerful and glamorous player, propelled to media celebrity by marrying world renowned actress Ingrid Thulin. He was Prime Minister Olof Palme's tennis partner and together with his close friend Ingmar Bergman he shaped the Swedish film industry. The story of Harry Schein is one of great success and deep tragedy. Five years ago Maud Nycander's documentary Palme broke box-office records. Together with Jannike Åhlund and Kersti Grunditz Brennan she's now followed up on that success with an equally strong and well-told film.



Jannike Åhlund, Kersti Grunditz Brennan, Maud Nycander. Maud Nycander was born in 1960. She is the director of numerous successful documentaries and received Prix Italia for *The Nun*. Two sisters who have been missing for the past three days are found brutally murdered. Edda and Jói both detectives determined to be the ones who solve the puzzle. When gruesome details of the case start to come out the focus of the investigation turns to the city's worst. The film follows the grief stricken mother dealing with her lost and the bewildered brother of the lead detective Edda who's dealing with life after prison. All the stories combines into a thrilling novelistic mosaic tale.

Anton Sigurðsson. Anton Sigurðsson is an Icelandic director. He became the youngest Director in Icelandic Film History in 2014 with the film Graves and Bones. Cruelty is Anton's second feature



film. The film is making headlines all over Iceland, and has become a huge box office success, making it the second highest grossing film in Iceland.

Zaid is a successful surgeon and lives in a fancy apartment with his pregnant girlfriend. One night Zaid's younger brother, Yasin, knocks on his door and asks his brother for money. Zaid refuses. A few days later Yasin gets assaulted and killed. Zaid feels forced to find out who murded his brother and embarks on a mission to eliminate all the criminal gangs in Copenhagen. He disguises himself and takes on the criminal underworld. But Zaid's persistent battle results in serious consequences for himself and his family, and he has to decide if the price of revenge is worth it all.

Fenar Ahmad. Fenar Ahmad was born 1981 in Czechoslovakia, and came to Denmark as an Iraqi refugee. In 2010 he graduated from the alternative Danish film school Super16 where he made the



short film Megaheavy, which was selected for the Berlinale and screened at a large number of festivals. The film was honoured with a Danish Robert award for best short fiction. Flow from 2014, was Ahmad's feature debut about a young man dreaming of becoming a rapper, and premiered at CPH PIX and was screened at London Film Festival. Darkland is his second film

Five years ago Arild Andresen won the Dragon Award Best Nordic Film for The Orheim Company. Now he's back with a film dealing with a taboo subject that can't leave anyone unshaken. For what can a father do when he feels nothing for his child? Kjetil, a Norwegian offshore worker is a recent widower, now left alone to take care of his adopted six year old son, Daniel. To find out more about the boy background Kjetil decides to bring Daniel back to Colombia. The trip will change their life forever.

Arild Andresen. Director and screenwriter Arild Andresen born 1967 started out making short films and commercials. In 2006, he directed the youth drama miniseries Boys Will Be Boys, the first Nor-



wegian production nominated for an EMMY. Andresen's debut feature, The Liverpool Goalie from 2010, won both the Crystal Bear and a special mention at the Berlingle Generation 2011. His next feature. The Orheim Company from 2012 won the Dragon Award for Best Nordic Film at Gothenburg Film Festival. Andersen is currently in preproduction as Conceptual Director on the TV series Home Ground, a Motlys and NRK production.

Tommaso Mottola. Tommaso Mottola was educated as an architect but entered the international film milieu in his twenties as an assistant to Milos Forman. His debut as feature film director



is in 1992 with *The Floating Island*. In the 90's he was a Board Member of State Film Co-production Committee, in 1994 he co-founded Capalbio Cinema International Film Festival, which he directs since 1999.

The explosion in the Kings Bay coal mine on Svalbard in 1962 took 21 lives. The sitting Social democratic government had to resign and the conservatives came to power for the first time since 1945. What if the explosion wasn't an accident, but part of a power play between Russia and the US about control of the Arctic? Kings Bay is an intense thriller about a tragedy that effected an entire nation.

Stig Svendsen. After two years in film school in Oslo, Stig Svendsen made his debut in 2002 with the short film Loose Ends, which has been screened in festivals worldwide. Stig made his first feature with



the adventure family film The Radio Pirates in 2007. In 2012 Stig made his second feature film, Elevator, starring Shirley Knight, Joey Slotnick, John Getz and Devin Ratray. Kings Bay is his third feature.

In a remote Finnish village in Lapland, a retiring policeman gets caught up in between two men trying to kill each other. The conflict leaves the area in a state of vengeance, and while trying to prevent the violence between the young men, the policeman is forced to face his past mistakes. Law of the Land is a modern borderline western, set in the Arctic desert of the North, on both sides of the northern Finnish-Swedish border.

Jussi Hiltunen. Jussi Hiltunen is awarded filmmaker from northern Finland. Hiltunen graduated from Kemi-Tornio University of Applied Sciences in 2011. His short film All Hallow's Week was



selected to Berlinale in 2012 and won several awards in international festivals. *Law of the Land* is his debut feature film




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
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
