Blackwater Händelser vid vatten

Carmen Curlers

Carmen Curlers is about the entrepreneur Axel Byvang and the resourceful housewife Birthe Windfeld who starts the fastest growing enterprise in the world in the 1960s: Carmen Curlers. The story accelerates in 1963 when Axel stumbles across an invention: the electric curler. Despite opposition, debts and the locals who think he is crazy, he and Birthe manage to create an international success.

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
