## Watching films

#### Festival screenings

Industry accredited delegates get access to the festival's film programme. An Industry accreditation grants you the opportunity to watch films in cinemas every day, provided that there are available seats. Attendees with Industry PRO, VIP, TV Drama Vision, Nordic Film Market and Press accreditations can also pick up tickets for festival screenings taking place the same day or the next at the Industry Ticket pick-up at Hotel Draken. Remember to bring your accreditation.



### **Nordic Film Market**

Nordic Film Market offers a vibrant showcase of projects, talents and trends from the Nordics, with buyers, sales agents, producers, festival programmes and other key industry professionals attending from all over the world.

The market presents new and upcoming films from the Nordics, including Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland and Iceland. The 2024 line-up consists of 20 completed feature films, 15 Works in Progress, and 17 films in development presented at the market's co-production platform Discovery. This year, we also introduce a special

section with case studies exploring innovation within new Nordic projects. We are welcoming more than 500 key industry delegates from 33 countries to Göteborg.

The Nordic Film Market delegates are invited to take part in the screenings and presentations in Göteborg Film Festival's multiplex cinema Biopalatset. The Industry Centre is at Clarion Hotel Draken, providing excellent meeting venues for one-on-one meetings, networking, and social events.

## Göteborg Film Fund welcomes filmmakers to the festival

In 2021, the Göteborg Film Fund supported filmmakers in Brazil, Sudan, Ukraine, and Kurdish regions spanning Iraq, Iran, Turkey, and Syria. Since 2022, it has focused on Ukraine's film industry with funding schemes like development support and residencies. This year, the Göteborg Film Festival features two fund-supported films.

The Ukrainian director and film critic Elena Rubashevska, also the vice president of Fipresci, spent the summer of 2023 in a residency in Göteborg and now serves as one of this year's Fipresci jury members.

Before directing, Emilie graduated from the Royal Danish Academy with an MA in Art & Architecture. Transitioning from fine arts to film, she is known for being a sensitive observer and a visually strong narrator.




Tintin Scheynius Producer, Sweden

Throughout the year, Göteborg and West Sweden provide a lively environment for film and audiovisual production.

### **REGION VÄSTRA GÖTALAND**

Region Västra Götaland has created a strong position in Scandinavia and internationally due to a vivid film industry, well-built infrastructure, and highly acclaimed production and post-production companies. Here, directors like Ruben Östlund, Tarik Saleh, Sanna Lenken, Lars von Trier, Ella Lemhagen, Thomas Vinterberg, Lisa James Larsson and Erik Poppe have filmed Oscar and Palme d'Or winners and other films and drama series selected for the most prestigious festivals internationally. And, of course, the big audience successes on cinema and streaming platforms.

### FILM i VÄST

Film i Väst is Scandinavia's leading regional film fund and has co-produced more than 1.300 films and drama series since 1992. Thanks to great co-operation with Swedish and international producers over 100 films have been screened in Cannes, Berlin, Venice and Toronto. The co-productions have received twelve Oscar nominations since 2011 and eleven Palme d'Or nominations including Ruben Östlund's winners The Square and Triangle of Sadness. Thomas Vinterberg won an Oscar in 2021 for Another Round, and Joachim Trier's The Worst Person in the World was double nominated for Oscars in 2022, 2023 Ruben Östlund was triple Oscar nominated for his Triangle of Sadness and Oliver Hermanus double nominated for his Living. Film i Väst is a part of Region Västra Götaland. filmivast.se

### **FILMSERVICE**

Filmservice.se is Film i Väst's online service for the film and TV industry, mainly aimed at Film i Väst's co-productions in

Scandinavia. This unique database is a useful tool for producers, line producers and other functions to get accessibility to the film industry and its suppliers in Region Västra Götaland, including production and post-production companies, film workers, actors, extras, and suppliers of goods and services. It is a regional location register for all 49 municipalities and the "Green Register" for young people who want to enter the film industry. Filmservice.se
